- Commercial Sex Acts
- Involuntary Servitude
- Peonage
- Debt Bondage
- Slavery

United Nations Definition of Trafficking in Persons (from the Protocol to Prevent, Suppress and Punish Trafficking in Persons, Especially Women and Children, supplementing the United Nations Convention against Transnational Organized Crime (article 3 (a))

Trafficking is the...

- Recruitment
- Transportation
- Transfer
- Harboring

Receipt

...of a person



By means of...

- threat
- force
- coercion
- abduction
- fraud
- abuse of power or of a position of vulnerability
- Giving or receiving of payments or benefits to achieve the consent of a person having control over another person



For the purpose of exploitation...

Exploitation shall include, at minimum:

- The prostitution of others or other forms of sexual exploitation
- Forced labor or services
- Slavery or practices similar to slavery
- Servitude
- The removal of organs
